Intentional Teaching is a set of data-driven strategies used to teach essential job skills that can be adapted to individuals of all abilities and learning styles. Attendees will participate in a single day of online training to learn:

SYSTEMATIC INSTRUCTION STRATEGIES:

Through *job analysis*, attendees will learn to identify the essential tasks and responsibilities of a job.

Through *task analysis*, attendees will identify and analyze job skills into teachable steps that can be customized for any student.

DESCRIPTIVE NOTETAKING IN DATA COLLECTION:

Using descriptive notetaking to track students' performance & supports utilized can help instructors achieve a more comprehensive understanding of overall progress.

Attendees will learn how to use descriptive notetaking & data collection to inform the teaching process.
